Explore Sacsayhuaman Ruins and witness a marvel of Inca engineering. Perched high above Cusco, this colossal ceremonial center boasts massive stones, perfectly fitted together with remarkable precision. Built over 50 years, its mysterious origins and grand design continue to captivate visitors.



### “QENQO: UNVEIL THE MYSTERIES OF INCA RITUALS”

Visit the Ruins of Qenqo and delve into a world shrouded in Inca mystery. Hidden in the hills near Cusco, this intriguing site boasts labyrinthine subterranean passages and enigmatic zigzagging stone channels. Imagine ancient rituals unfolding around the carved stone table, where mummification ceremonies once took place.



### “PUKA PUKARA: WITNESS THE MASTERY OF INCA FORTIFICATIONS AND STRATEGY”

Our Cusco City Tour also takes you to visit the Ruins of Puka Pukara, an ancient testament to Inca military strategy. Perched on a commanding hilltop, this impressive fortress was a crucial checkpoint and defensive stronghold..

Our tour also takes you to the Ruins of Tambomachay, an ancient sanctuary dedicated to the Inca God of Water. Nestled in a serene landscape, Tambomachay features intricate aqueducts, cascading fountains, and meticulously crafted stonework that highlight the Incas' reverence for water and their advanced engineering skills.



“DISCOVER THE CATHEDRAL OF CUSCO: A TESTAMENT TO TIMELESS ART AND HISTORY”

At the heart of the city, we also visit the Cathedral of Cusco, a breathtaking gem of colonial architecture. This 16th-century masterpiece, constructed atop an ancient Inca temple, showcases a stunning blend of Renaissance and Baroque styles. Marvel at its intricately decorated interiors, including a remarkable collection of colonial paintings and the famous depiction of the Last Supper with a unique twist, featuring guinea pig.

Finally, explore the magnificent Qoricancha Temple, also known as the Santo Domingo Church. Once the most sacred temple of the Inca Empire, Qoricancha was dedicated to the Sun God, Inti, and adorned with gold and precious stones. Following the Spanish conquest, it was transformed into the Santo Domingo Church, seamlessly blending Inca stonework with colonial baroque architecture.

## TOUR DESCRIPTION

Our guide will meet you at your hotel in Cusco. First, we head to the impressive Ceremonial Center of Sacsayhuaman, a vast structure overlooking Cusco. Known for its massive, perfectly fitted stones, Sacsayhuaman's origins remain a mystery, though many believe it was built during the reign of Pachacutec, the founder of the Inca Empire.

Next, we explore the intriguing Ruins of Qenqo, with its zigzag stone channels and underground passages, once used for rituals and mummification. Following this, we head to the nearby Ruins of Puka Pukara, a military fortress strategically positioned to protect the city.

Afterward, we visit Tambomachay, also known as the “Temple of Water,” where you’ll admire the Incas’ advanced aqueduct systems and their spiritual reverence for water.

Returning to Cusco, we explore the sacred Temple of Koricancha, once the most important religious site of the Inca Empire. Known for its golden walls, it was the center of Inca spiritual life.

Finally, we visit the majestic Cathedral of Cusco, built in the 16th century on the foundations of an Inca temple. Inside, you’ll find stunning colonial art, including Marcos Zapata’s famous painting of the Last Supper, featuring guinea pig as the main course.

After an enriching day discovering Cusco’s rich history and landmarks, we’ll drop you off at your hotel.
